

„RNWORKS Local debate” - Budapest
(2014.10.30. Location: KalyiJag School)

The participants have reaffirmed their willingness to partake in the RNWorks project.

The following recommendations were put forth at the meeting:

1. Varga Gusztáv offered to host the 2014 RNWorks II Steering Committee Meeting on December 9-10.
2. Peter Wendl indicated that they are currently collecting best practices in roma integration, which could be shared with RNWorks. Suggested OSI as possible stakeholder.
3. Molnár Attila will help in the identification and involvement of organizations who could cooperate in RNWorks. He also recommended involving CEU (Central European University) as a stakeholder, because they have a significant number of local roma students and also from surrounding countries.
4. Joó Lajos offered expanding the "good practices" with a third page, which would list 5-10 parameters that help with local adaptation.

Agreed that these 5 participants who form a " RNWorks Pentagon" would each list a satellite network of partners, with the aim of building a living, operating network.

Each partner would send DIA a good practice in the form of the established template.
